

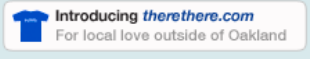

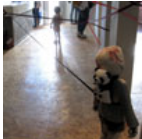

The recipients represent a wide range of social interests and populations, and are not restricted by any political agenda.

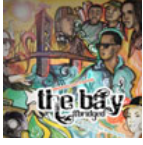
AGRICULTURAL INSTITUTE OF MARIN

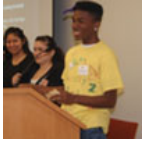
38th NOTES
